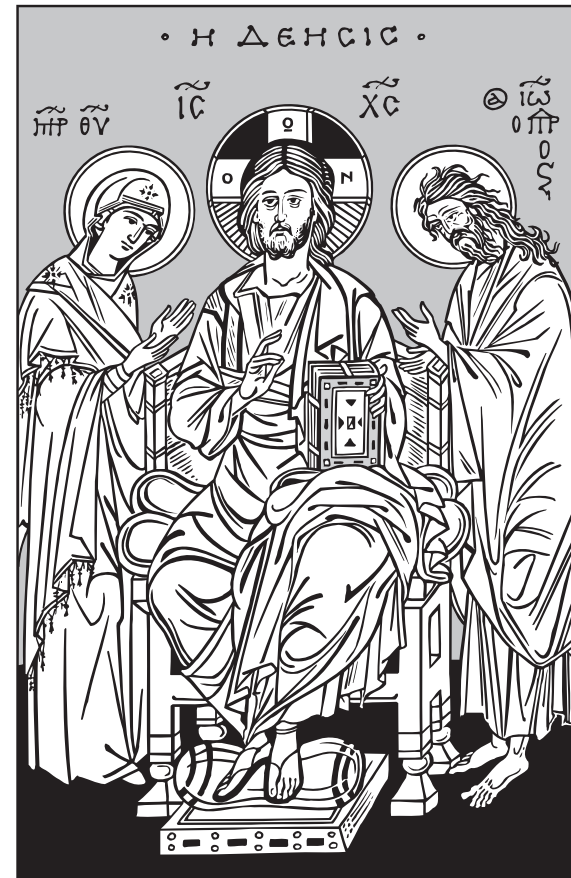

SCRIPTURE READINGS

Epistle – Ephesians 4:1-6

Brethren...I, a prisoner for the Lord, beg you to lead a life worthy of the calling to which you have been called, with all lowliness and meekness, with patience, forbearing one another in love, eager to maintain the unity of the Spirit in the bond of peace. There is one body and one Spirit, just as you were called to the one hope that belongs to your call, one Lord, one faith, one baptism, one God and Father of us all, who is above all and through all and in all.

Gospel – Luke 13:10-17

At that time, Jesus was teaching in one of the synagogues on the Sabbath. And there was a woman who had had a spirit of infirmity for eighteen years; she was bent over and could not fully straighten herself. And when Jesus saw her, He called her and said to her, "Woman, you are freed from your infirmity." And He laid His hands upon her, and immediately she was made straight, and she praised God. But the ruler of the synagogue, indignant because Jesus had healed on the Sabbath, said to the people, "There are six days on which work ought to be done; come on those days and be healed, and not on the Sabbath day." Then the Lord answered him, "You hypocrites! Does not each of you on the Sabbath untie his ox or his ass from the manger, and lead it away to water it? And ought not this woman, a daughter of Abraham whom Satan bound for eighteen years, be loosed from this bond on the Sabbath day?" As He said this, all His adversaries were put to shame; and all the people rejoiced at all the glorious things that were done by Him.

DEC. 9 – CHURCH CHRISTMAS BAKE SALE 10-2. Based on last week's Ladies Guild meeting we are going to try something different this year. We are going to bake *based on preorders*. Consequently, if you would like to purchase any of the following items: poppy seed rolls, nut rolls, apricot rolls, sour cream cake, egg bread, pita (pan or roll) triangles (spinach w/cheese, or cheese, or mixed), **PLEASE** preorder on the form available on the candle stand. about taking a few preorder forms and share with friends, coworkers, family?). We **MUST** have the preorder forms returned NO LATER THAN SUNDAY DEC. 2. Cookies, brownies, baklava, specialty cookies will be available for sale at the bake sale either by the pound or by item – they cannot be preordered.

Thurs., Dec. 7 & Fri., Dec. 8 from 9 a.m. till ??? are the days dedicated to the preparation for our bake sale. We are in desperate need for assistance during these days. ***PLEASE, PLEASE, PLEASE*** volunteer a few hours either or each of these days. We know many of you work but hopefully you will come after work for at least an hour or two and assist with clean up. Those of you not working out of your home, PLEASE come and assist us during the day. All of us are one year older – the pans, the racks are becoming a little heavier; the bending is becoming a little more difficult; the standing more tedious. We truly NEED your time – your assistance.

Also for the bake sale we are asking for homemade cookies, candy, brownies. I will have containers available next Sunday for anyone who would like to use for transporting their baked goods to church. We do ask you attach to your baked goods: the type of cookie/candy/brownie and a list of ingredients(not the amounts) esp. the type of nut, if used.

Our "Giving from the Heart" project continues today through Sunday December 10. We are collecting donations for EXODUS PLACE –a nonprofit organization providing homeless Michigan veterans housing, counseling, food, clothing, etc. A list of items is posted in the lobby with copies available on top of library bookshelf and on the tables in the coffee room.
